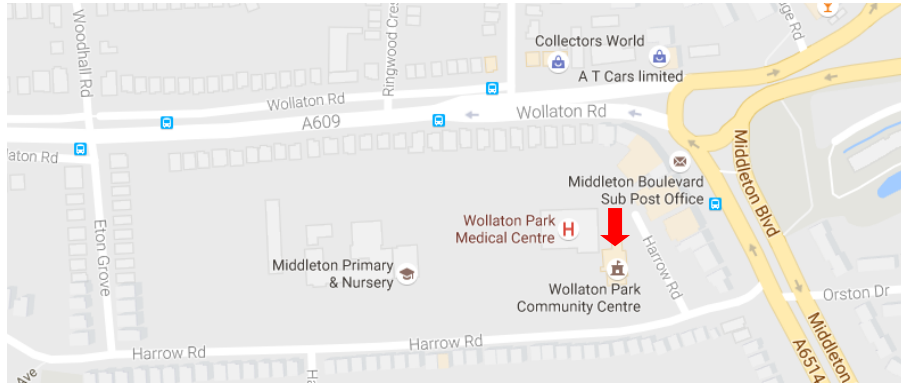


## DIRECTIONS



Wollaton Park Community Centre, Harrow Road. Wollaton Nottingham NG8 1FG.

### From the South:

M1 Junction 24. Take the A453 towards Clifton past Nottingham Trent University Clifton campus. Continue onto the ring road (Clifton Boulevard; A52). Keep in the right hand lane. Pass Queens Medical Centre on your right. Keep in the left hand lane and proceed to a roundabout; take the first exit signed A609 towards Ilkeston. Turn left at the first traffic lights onto Elton Grove. Turn left onto Harrow Road. The venue is on the left after the Medical Centre.

### From the North:

M1 Junction 26; Take the A610 and keep on the A610 to the A6514; turn right. Follow the road to a large roundabout; keep in the outside lane and take the third exit signed A609 towards Ilkeston. Turn left at the traffic lights onto Elton Grove. Turn left onto Harrow Road. The venue is on the left after the Medical Centre.

Please note that you **cannot** enter Harrow Road from Middleton Boulevard. You must proceed along Wollaton Road then turn into Eton Grove at the traffic lights. Turn left onto Harrow Road. **You can** leave Harrow Road onto Middleton Boulevard.

## RULES

- All sections of the Show are open to all members of The British Cactus and Succulent Society
- Judging and classification of plants shall be in accordance with the **11th Edition of The BCSS Handbook of Shows**. The judges' reserve the right to withhold any award or prize card, if in their opinion no exhibit in any particular class merits such an award. Any plant that in the opinion of the judge is infected by pests or disease will be removed from the show and not qualify for any award.
- All entry forms **MUST** be completed and returned to the show secretary **not later than Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024. NO ENTRIES will be accepted on the day of the show without the authority of the show secretary.**
- **Entries are free**, and no prize money will be given.
- Entries will be restricted to **two per exhibitor per class**
- **All staging must be completed by 10:30am on the morning of the show.** The show manager or stewards acting on his behalf reserves the right to re-position any plant, either for reason of space or aesthetic presentation.
- **Exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor** and are staged at the owner's own risk. Entries should NOT contain more than one plant in a pot. The committee accept no responsibility for any loss or damage, but all reasonable care will be taken.
- Any appeal against the judge's decision must be lodged with the show secretary in writing within an hour of the completion of judging, together with a complaints fee of £10.00, which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
- Points will be awarded for each class as follows

First .....	5
Second .....	3
Third.....	2
Highly Commended.....	1

**All points awarded will be counted towards trophies.**

- **Entry to the show constitutes acceptance of the rules.** Exhibitors should read the schedule carefully. The decision of the show committee shall be final in all matters. Judges may, dependent on quality of exhibits, withhold awards in any particular class.
- Members are encouraged to bring plants for sale on the Branch Plant Sales table. Each plant must be in an individual pot, with a clearly marked label denoting the sale price and vendor. The Branch takes a 20% commission of any sale.
